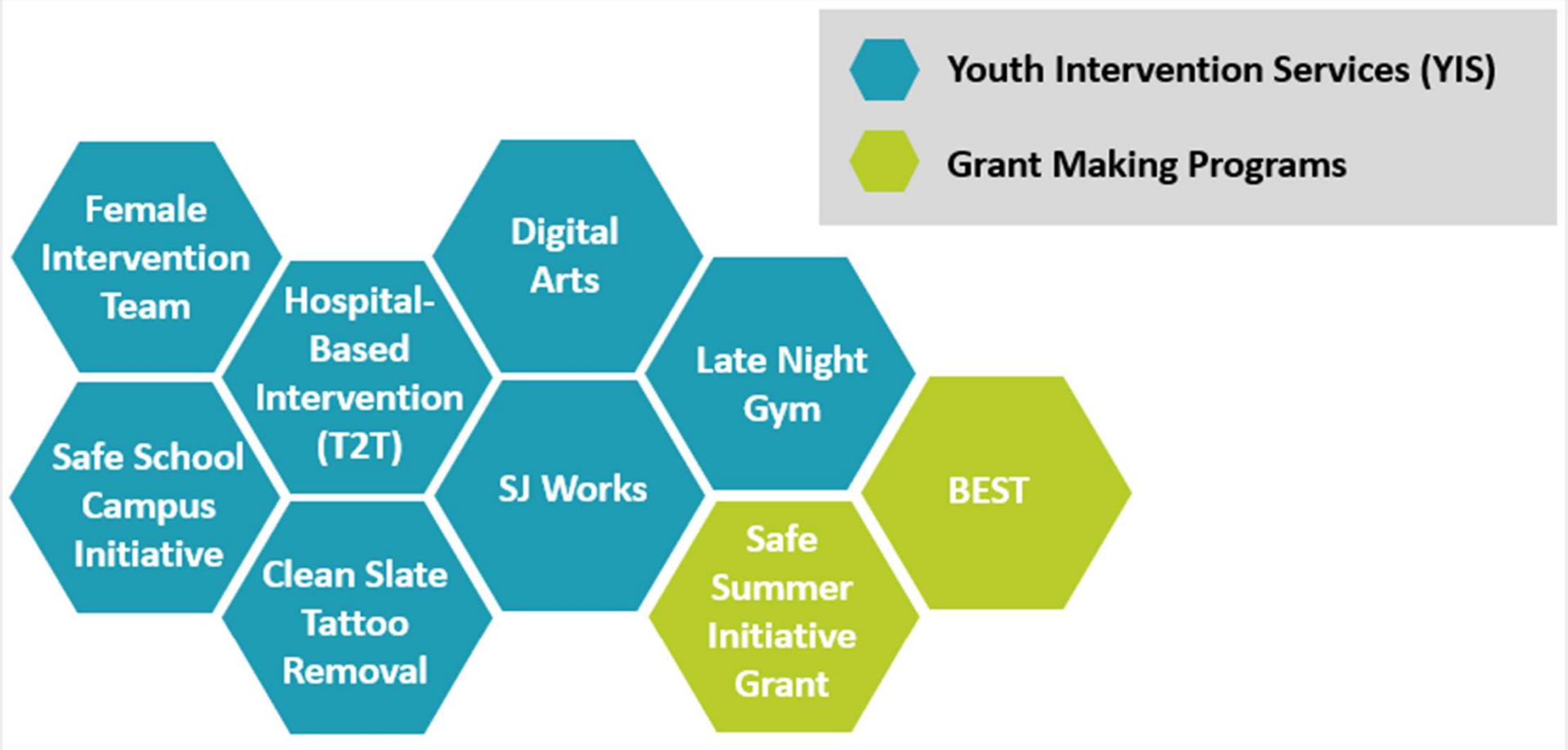

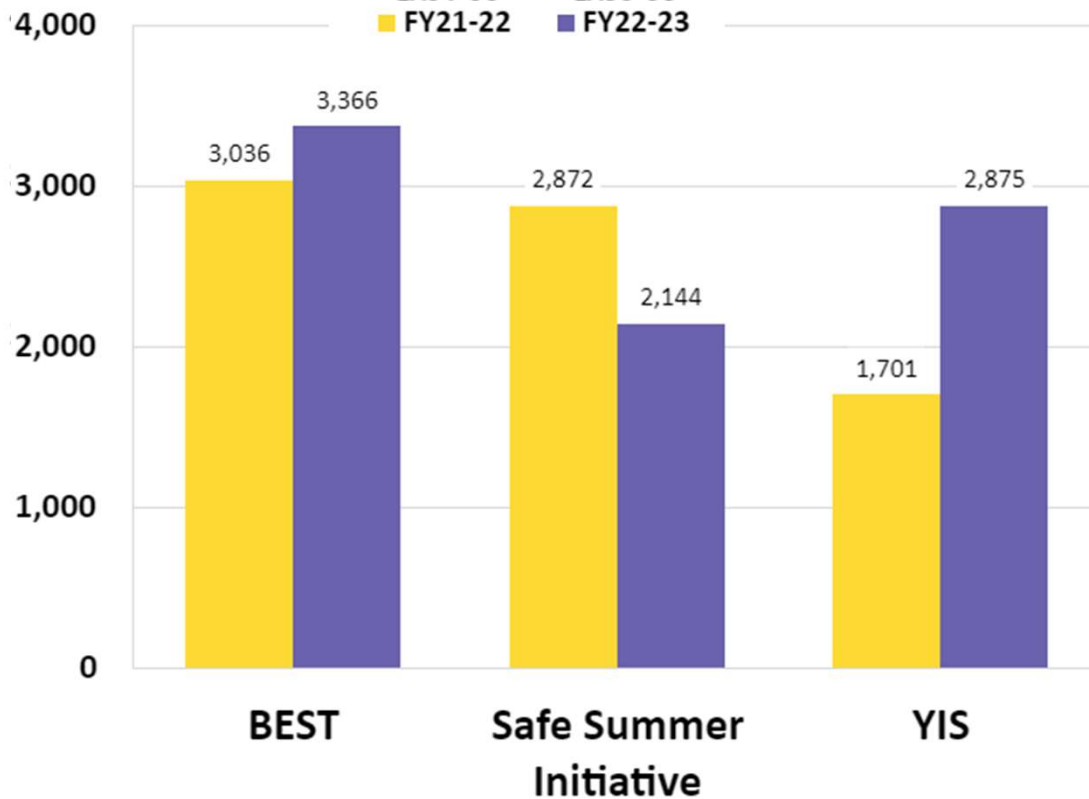

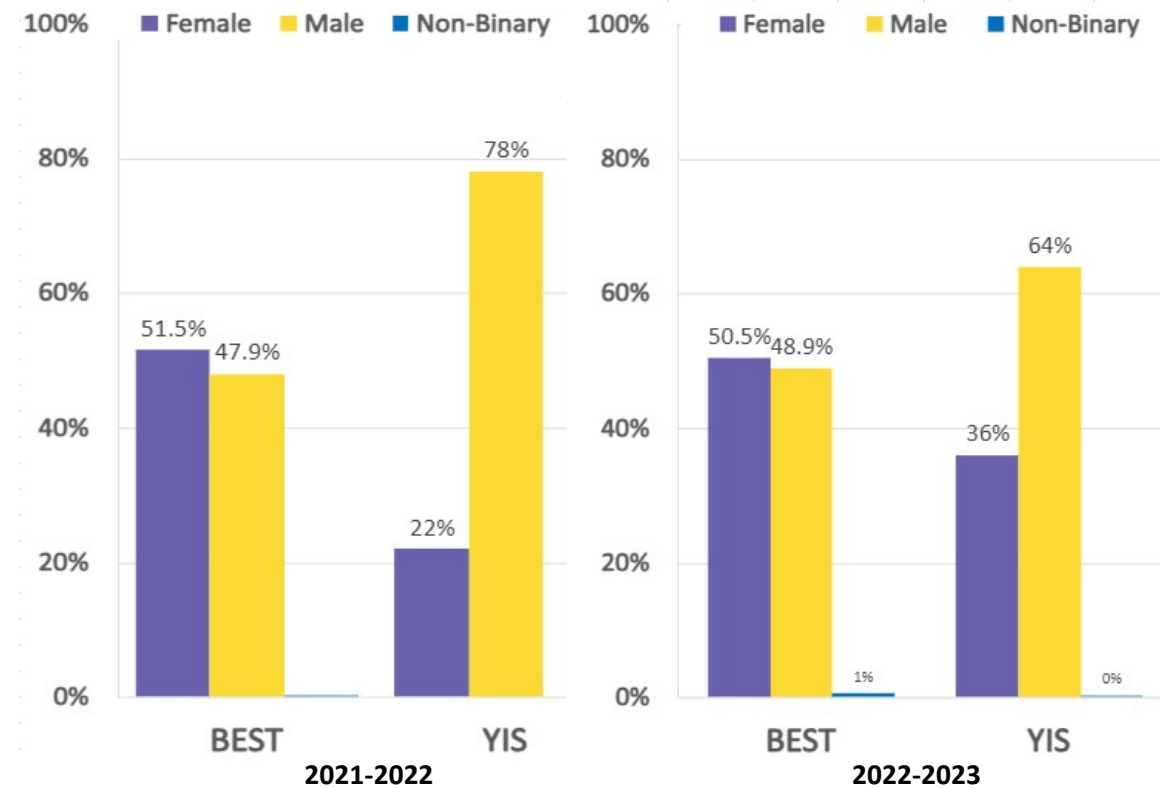

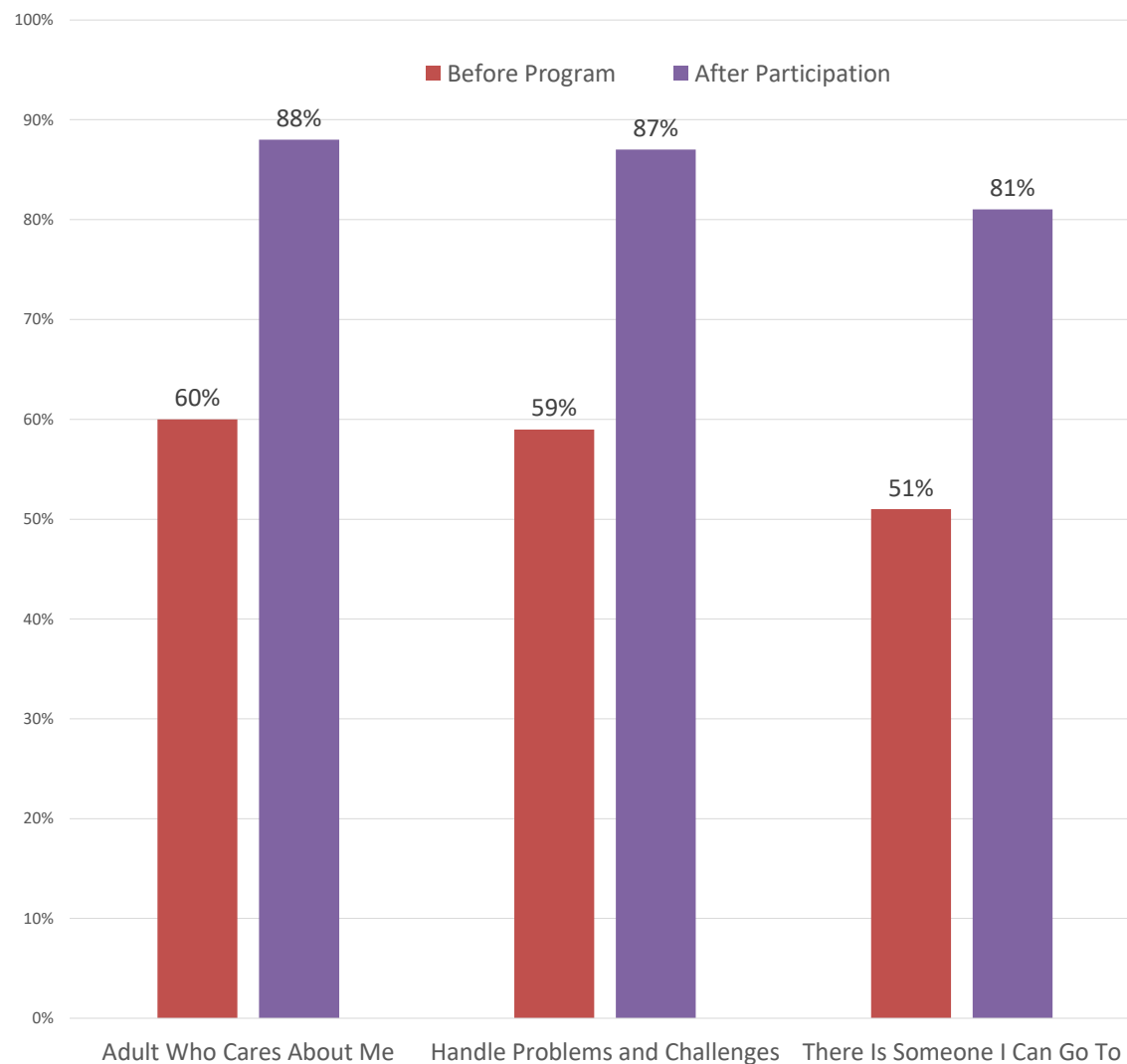
PARTICIPANTS BY GENDER

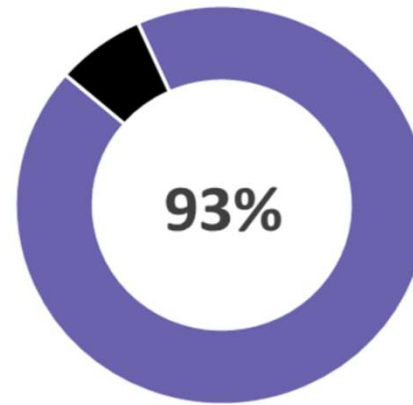

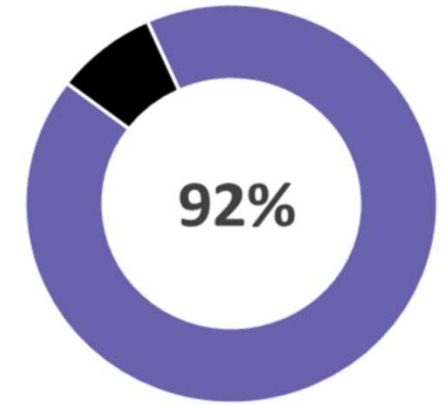

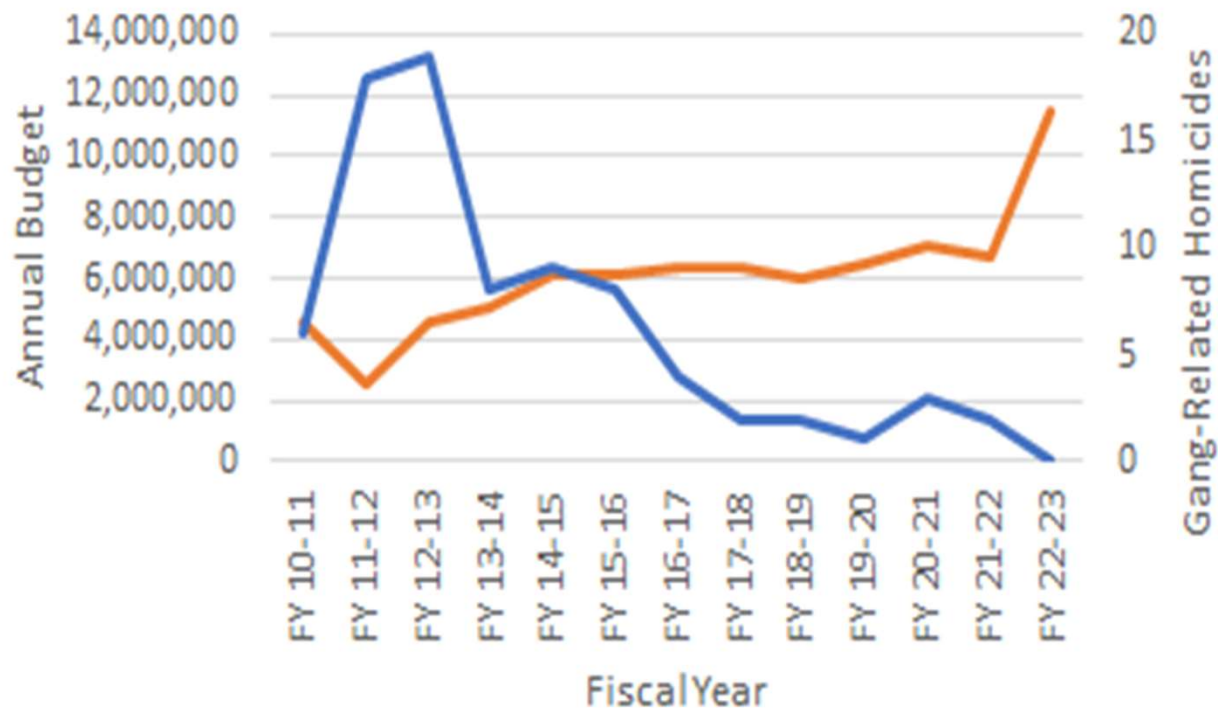

IMPACT OVER TIME

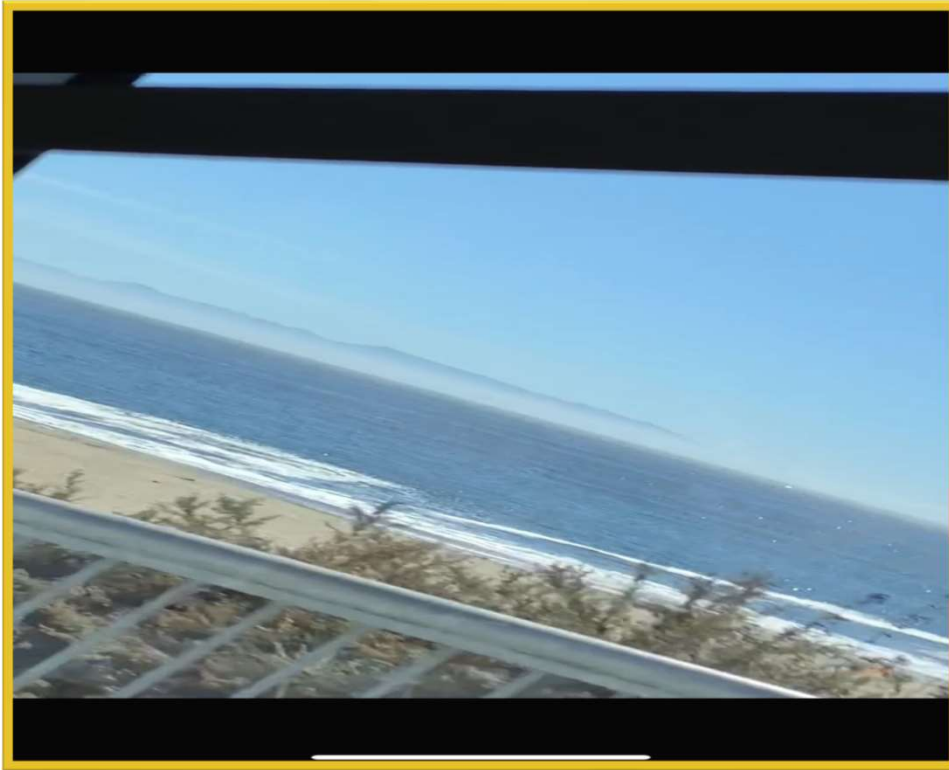
