SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF THE CESAR CHAVEZ DAY FLAG RAISING SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

# **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. Retroactive approval of the Cesar Chavez Day Flag Raising scheduled on March 29, 2024, as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the April 30, 2024, Council Agenda for action.

# **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Cesar Chavez Day Flag Raising was held on Friday, March 29, 2024, at San Jose City Hall and sponsored by Councilmember Sergio Jimenez. The raising of the flag celebrates the legacy of Cesar Chavez, labor leader and civil rights activist who, with Dolores Huerta, co-founded the National Farm Workers Association (later the United Farm Workers Union, UFW) in 1962. Cesar Chavez is an important figure in San Jose history where his former home is a Historical Landmark.

The display of the United Farm Workers Flag on March 29, 2024, is permitted under Council Policy 2-1, Section C.3 - Flags Displayed in Conjunction With Official Ceremonial Items: "Other flags may be displayed in conjunction with official actions, ceremonial items, or proclamations of the City Council."

#### **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events.
