**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF LIGHTING FOR LIGHT THE NIGHT FOR FALLEN
FIREFIGHTERS SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, COUNCIL
DISTRICT 8, AND COUNCIL DISTRICT 5 AS A CITY COUNCIL
SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT
DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the Tower and Rotunda lighting for Light the Night scheduled for May 3 - 4, 2024 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups that supported the events.
3. Place the item on the April 30, 2024, Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Tower and Rotunda will be lit in red to honor and pay tribute to our fallen firefighters. The National Fallen Firefighters Foundation created Light the Night for Fallen Firefighters 26 years ago. Since its creation, this event has expanded to include not only fire stations but private residences, public buildings and more. Councilmember's Bien Doan, Domingo Candelas and Peter Ortiz have sponsored the lighting of the Tower and Rotunda which will take place on May 3-4, 2024.

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ANALYSIS

City Council Policy 7-14, City Hall Event Lighting Policy, Sections B.1 and C.1 allows Rotunda and Tower lighting in conjunction with proclamations for official actions or ceremonial items as approved by City Council.

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Bien Doan will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 7, Council District 8, Council District 5, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
