SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF LIGHTING FOR BLACK APRIL SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the Tower and Rotunda lighting for Black April scheduled for April 30 May 2, 2024 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups that supported the events.
- 3. Place the item on the April 30, 2024, Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Black April Flag Raising and Gala will be held at San José City Hall West Plaza and Rotunda and is sponsored by Councilmember Bien Doan. This special event serves to commemorate and proclaim the month of April as Black April in recognition of the fall of Saigon, April 30, 1975. The Tower and Rotunda will be lit in yellow and red in honor of the Vietnamese Freedom and Heritage flag. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

City Council Policy 7-14, City Hall Event Lighting Policy, Sections B.1 and C.1 allows Rotunda and Tower lighting in conjunction with proclamations for official actions or ceremonial items as approved by City Council.

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Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Bien Doan will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 7, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
