RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the Mexican Flag raising scheduled on September 15, 2017 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.

3. Place the item on the September 19, 2017 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Mexican Flag raising will be held on September 15, 2017 at Mexican Heritage Plaza and sponsored by Vice Mayor Carrasco, Councilmember Peralez, Jimenez, Arenas, Rocha. This special event is to celebrate the rich Mexican Culture that has greatly impacted the City of San José. The event is free and open to the public.

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ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Vice Mayor Magdalena Carrasco, Councilmember Peralez, Jimenez, Arenas, Rocha will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 2,3,5,8,9, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
