REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

This supplemental memorandum is to request City Council to give Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services (PRNS) staff the flexibility to modify the requested funding amount for applications to the Santa Clara County for Grant Funding for the All-Inclusive Playgrounds Program grant.

RECOMMENDATION

- (a) Approve the recommended park sites listed in Attachment B to the memorandum to Council for the City's application to apply for the County of Santa Clara grant for the development of all-inclusive playgrounds.
- (b) Allow PRNS staff the flexibility in requesting funds when applying for the proposed nine park sites for the All-Inclusive Playgrounds Program grant.

ANALYSIS

PRNS has submitted a memorandum to City Council for the October 3, 2017 meeting requesting approval of the recommended park sites for the All-Inclusive Playgrounds Program grant. The memorandum has an attachment with the nine sites and the proposed requested grant funds for each site. Staff is currently working on the applications and through this process may need to increase or decrease the funding request per identified site due to the final project scope which
