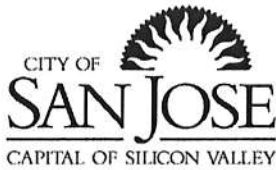

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds in Special Event Accounts.

Councilmember Raul Peralez, with support from local businesses and community volunteers, will sponsor the raising of the POW! WOW! San José flag on October 23, 2017 at the City Hall Plaza. The event is free and open to the public. The display of the POW! WOW! San José flag is permitted under Council Policy 2-1, Section C – Flags Displayed in conjunction with Official Ceremonial Items: “Other flags may be displayed in conjunction with official actions, ceremonial items, or proclamations of the City Council.”
