## **RECOMMENDATION**

### **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The PATH San José Fundraiser will be held on October 25, 2017 at SP2 Communal Bar + Restaurant and sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. This special event will bring together community leaders and organizations to celebrate and donate to the continued support that PATH San José has provided to our homeless individuals in the downtown area.

Additionally, approximately \$250 of minimal appetizers will be purchased for the event.

#### **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure

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requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments, and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
