This treatment of us is very inhumane and how many deaths does it take to have actions taken to resolve these problems. More low-income housing is needed to help us transition out of homelessness to affordable housing.

We also would like to see the weather be increased to 50 degrees so we have another chance for the Tully center to be open. Our lives are important. The City needs to step up and start caring about the most venerable population in San Jose. Thank you for your consideration.
