A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE ACCEPTING THE OFFICE OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION FISCAL YEAR 2017 INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE INVITED AWARDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$425,769, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL **DOCUMENTS** AND RELATED AMENDMENTS. INCLUDING ONLINE CERTIFICATIONS AT TIME OF REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST

WHEREAS, in the early 1980s, the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention began development of nationwide law enforcement training on child sexual exploitation; and

WHEREAS, in February 2003, the San José Police Department ("SJPD") applied for and was awarded its first Internet Crimes Against Children ("ICAC") grant from the United States Department of Justice ("USDOJ") and, since that time, has applied for and received several ICAC continuation grants; and

WHEREAS, ICAC grants have provided funding for overtime, equipment and vehicles for SJPD investigations, training of investigators, funding to host two national ICAC conferences, and equipment and training for investigators from eleven Bay Area counties who participate in the Silicon Valley ICAC Task Force; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2017, the SJPD submitted an application to the USDOJ for a grant to continue to fund activities as they relate to the Silicon Valley ICAC program, including salaries, training, and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the SJPD has been awarded the Fiscal Year 2017 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited Awards in the amount of \$425,769, for the period of July 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the ICAC grant is reimbursement based, and beginning on October 1, 2017, DOJ award recipients are required to certify each payment reimbursement request before submission. The certification represents the recipient's compliance with all applicable terms and conditions of the award, as well as statutory and regulatory requirements, and all related requirements that appear in the certifications and assurances for the award;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

- The Fiscal Year 2017 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Invited Awards in the amount of \$425,769 is hereby accepted.
- The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement and all related documents and to execute additional amendments and related documents, including online certifications at time of reimbursement request, without further City Council action.
