RAISING CEREMONY AND RECEPTION SPONSORED BY COUNCIL
DISTRICT 1 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO
EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS
AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the African American History Month Flag Raising Ceremony and Reception scheduled on February 2nd, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the December 5th, 2017 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The African American History Month Flag Raising Ceremony and Reception will be held on Friday, February 2nd, 2018 at the San José City Hall West Plaza & Rotunda and sponsored by Councilmember Chappie Jones. This special event celebrates African American History Month and the great contributions that the African American community has made to our community. The event is free and open to the public.

The display of the Pan-African Flag on February 2nd, 2018 is permitted under Council Policy 2-1, Section C.2 – Flags Displayed in Conjunction With Official Ceremonial Items: “Other flags may be displayed in conjunction with official actions, ceremonial items, or proclamations of the City Council.”

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ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events.
