SUBJECT: GP17-014. CITY-INITIATED GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT TO MODIFY THE LAND USE/TRANSPORTATION DIAGRAM TO ADDRESS MAPPING ERRORS AT LOCATIONS WITHIN THE RINCON SOUTH, JACKSON – TAYLOR, AND MARTHA GARDENS GENERAL PLAN GROWTH AREAS.

REASON FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL

At staff's request, City Council deferred item 10.1(h) from the November 28, 2017 Council meeting to the December 12, 2017 meeting, to allow staff an opportunity to address an error in the proposed Resolution, which inadvertently carried over text from a prior version of the Resolution. Staff has updated the Resolution to accurately reflect the proposed General Plan amendment to address mapping errors at locations within the Rincon South, Jackson – Taylor, and Martha Gardens General Plan Growth Areas.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff has addressed the errors in the proposed Resolution and recommends the following:

- (a) Consider the Determination of Consistency with the Envision San José 2040 General Plan Final Program Environmental Impact Report (Resolution No. 76041) and Supplemental Environmental Impact Report to the Envision San José General Plan Final Program Environmental Impact Report (Resolution No. 77617), and Addenda thereto.

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- (b) Adopt a Resolution approving a General Plan Amendment to address Land Use/Transportation Diagram errors at locations within the boundaries of the Rincon South Urban Village, Jackson-Taylor Specific Plan, and the Martha Gardens Specific Plan.
