A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE APPROVING THE DONATION OF EIGHT CITY SURPLUS VEHICLES WITH A CUMULATIVE VALUE OF \$42,500 TO SAN JOSE POLICE HISTORICAL SOCIETY, SAN JOSE FIRE MUSEUM, SILICON VALLEY CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION, SAN FRANCISCO POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND THE SPRING VALLEY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose (“City”) has identified eight vehicles as surplus because of age, mileage, mechanical condition, and obsolescence; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.16.250 of the San José Municipal Code permits the City Council to donate any surplus property valued in excess of \$1,500 to a public or governmental body or agency, volunteer fire department, or a non-profit corporation; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 1-20 “Donation of Surplus Personal Property” allows property worth more than \$1,500 and less than \$10,000 to be donated with Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the unit value of each of the eight surplus vehicles to be below \$10,000 and therefore eligible for donation pursuant to SJMC 4.16.250 and Council Policy 1-20; and

WHEREAS, the donation of surplus vehicles will benefit City residents by preserving and displaying San José public safety history, educating future first responders, protecting property, and preventing and investigating crimes against children;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The Council hereby approves the donation of eight City surplus vehicles with a cumulative value of \$42,500 to San José Police Historical Society, San José Fire Museum, Silicon Valley Career Technical Education, San Francisco Police Department, and the Spring Valley Volunteer Fire Department, including:

1. Six Fire Apparatus, one 1986 Pierce Pumper, one 1988 Pierce Snorkel and four 1994 Spartan Pumpers with an estimated cumulative value of \$34,500.
2. One 2007 Harley Davidson Police Motorcycle with an estimated value of \$4,000.
3. One 2009 Chevrolet Traverse with an estimated value of \$4,000.
