BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Community Meeting was held on January 20, 2018 at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. This special non-denominational event is sponsored by Vice Mayor Carrasco. This special event is to update the community on transportation issues. The event was free and open to the public.
