MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the 2018 State of the District scheduled on March 3, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the February 27, 2018 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

2018 State of the District will be held on March 3, 2018 at Lincoln High School Gymnasium and sponsored by Councilmember Dev Davis. This special event will include remarks from Councilmember Davis and other City Departments such as PRNS, SJPd, OES and DOT who will review their 2017 accomplishments as well as their plans for 2018 in District 6. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Dev Davis will report any cash or in-kind donations received for

the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 6, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
