RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the raising of the flags of the Republic of Ireland and City of Dublin on March 16, 2018 and display of the flags through March 19, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Place the item on the March 13th Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

In recognition of the St. Patrick's Day holiday, the contributions of the Irish-American community to the City of San José, and the vibrant, longstanding Sister City relationship between the cities of San José and Dublin, the flags of the Republic of Ireland and Dublin City will be raised on March 16th at City Hall Plaza and fly until March 19th. The flag raising is sponsored by Councilmember Johnny Khamis in coordination with the Office of Economic Development. There will be no ceremony associated with the raising of the flags and the occasion is free and open to the public.

The display of the flags of Ireland and Dublin from March 16th through the 19th is permitted under Council Policy 2-1, Flags of Governments Recognized by the United States: "Flags of the governments recognized by the United States may be displayed upon the request of the Mayor, a member of the City Council or the City Manager;" and Flags of Sister Cities: "The flags of official Sister Cities of San Jose may be displayed in conjunction with an event involving the Sister City."
