RECOMMENDATION

Defer a status report on actions related to San Jose Water Company to the May 07, 2018 meeting of the Transportation and Environment (T&E) Committee.

ANALYSIS

Staff will report on actions related to San Jose Water Company (SJWC) to update the T&E Committee on SJWC filings with the California Public Utilities (CPUC) to inform San José residents and businesses of the proposed water rate increases.

Staff has been collaborating with the Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) to identify potential methods of action. In addition, Staff has been tracking the status of SJWC filings that will increase water rates, including Advice Letters and tracking information regarding the SJWC General Rate Case application.

The CPUC will host a Public Participation Hearing regarding the SJWC General Rate Case. The Hearing has yet to be scheduled, but it is anticipated that it will occur in the second quarter of 2018. Due to ongoing review of the SJWC General Rate Case by the CPUC and Office of Ratepayer Advocates, staff requests a deferral of this item to the May 7, 2018 T&E Committee meeting.
