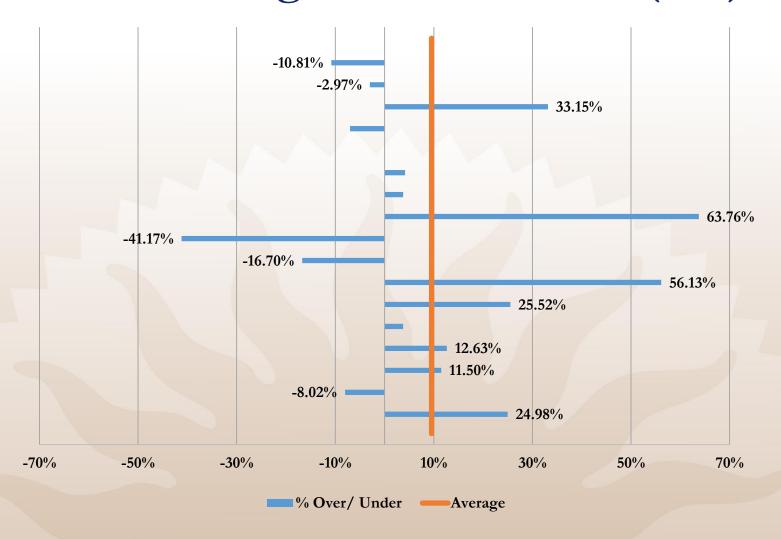

- Staff error



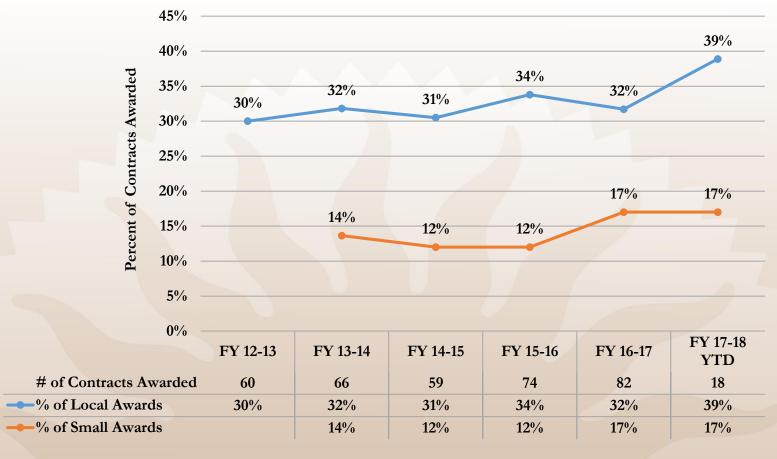
Staff Resource Issues

- Staff turnover requires increased Project Manager training needs



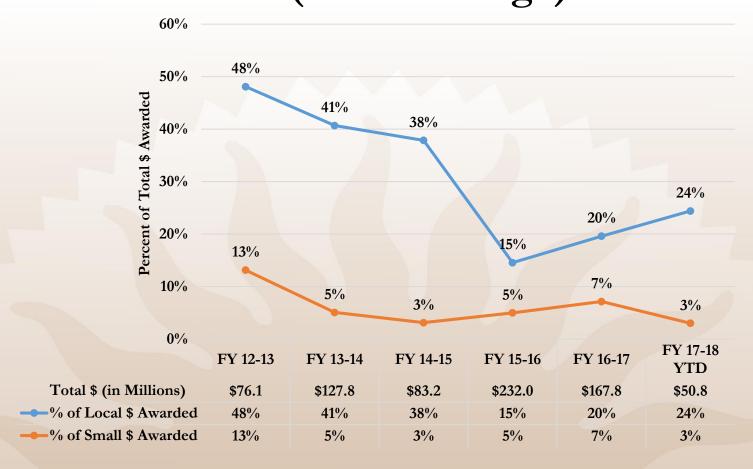
Local and Small Business Participation
