## RECOMMENDATION

## ANALYSIS

On February 14, 2018, the Rules and Open Government Committee dropped the above item from the PSFSS Committee Work Plan for January-June 2018 with direction to include the item on the Committee Work Plan for July-December 2018 when it is brought forward to Rules.

Since then, progress on the Mayor's Gang Prevention Task Force (MGPTF) Strategic Work Plan 2018-2020 has been made more quickly than staff originally anticipated. The MGPTF Strategic Work Plan will be presented to the MGPTF Policy Team on April 26, 2018.

For this reason, staff is requesting the addition of the MGPTF Strategic Work Plan 2018-2020 to the May 17, 2018 PSFSS Committee agenda to present the plan and seek approval to move the item forward to a City Council meeting in June 2018.
