SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL AND APPROVAL OF COMMUNITY EVENTS SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AS CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENTS TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENTS

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Meet and Greet with Tuscany Hills HOA on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at Viera Park as a City Council Sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Retroactively approve the Clean Up With Tam on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at College Connection Academy at Yerba Buena High School as a City Council Sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds;
3. Approve the following District 7 events as City Council sponsored Special Events and approve the expenditure of funds:
 - a. Ice Cream Social at Casa Real Apartments on Thursday, May 3, 2018 at Casa Real Apartments;
 - b. Cinco De Mayo at Santee on Friday, May 4, 2018 at Franklin McKinley Children's Initiative;
 - c. District 7 Youth Commission Appreciation BBQ on Sunday, May 6, 2018 at Emma Prusch Farm Park;
 - d. Clean Up With Tam on Saturday, June 23, 2018 at Fontaine Road Neighborhood;
 - e. Dump Your Junk on Saturday, August 18, 2018 at Windmill Springs Elementary School;
 - f. Dump Your Junk on Saturday, September 29, 2018 at Dahl Elementary School.

4. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the events.
5. Place the item on the May 15, 2018 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Council District 7 has planned these community events. The events are free and open to the public and are supported through the efforts of many neighborhoods, businesses, and community volunteers. Additionally, books, games, toys, and dollar store items will be purchased for raffle prizes, and a limited number of gift cards under \$50 may be purchased for raffle and volunteer appreciation. The raffle will be free and open to the public.

1. Meet and Greet with Tuscan Hills HOA will be held on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at Viera Park and sponsored by Councilmember Tam Nguyen. The event will bring the community together to learn about city services and resources. The event is free and open to the public.
2. Clean Up With Tam will be held on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at College Connection Academy at Yerba High School and sponsored by Councilmember Tam Nguyen. The event will bring the community together to clean up the neighborhood. The event is free and open to the public.
3. Ice Cream Social at Casa Real Apartments will be held on Thursday, May 3, 2018 at Casa Real Apartments and sponsored by Councilmember Tam Nguyen. The event will bring the community together to learn about city services and resources. The event is free and open to the public.
4. Cinco De Mayo at Santee will be held on Friday, May 4, 2018 at Franklin McKinley Children's Initiative and sponsored by the Santee Neighborhood Association and Councilmember Tam Nguyen. The event will bring the community together to celebrate and learn about Cinco De Mayo as well as city services. The event is free and open to the public.
5. District 7 Youth Commission Appreciation BBQ will be held on Sunday, May 6, 2018 at Emma Prusch Farm Park and sponsored by Councilmember Tam Nguyen. The event will recognize and celebrate accomplishments of the youth in the district. The event is free and open to the public.
6. Dump Your Junk will be held on Saturday, August 18, 2018 at Windmill Springs Elementary School and sponsored by Councilmember Tam Nguyen. The event will give

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the events will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Tam Nguyen will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the events on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 7, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the events. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
