- 3. Place the item on the June 5, 2018 Council Agenda for action.

### BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Council District 7 has planned these community events. The events are free and open to the public and are supported through the efforts of many neighborhoods, businesses, and community volunteers. Additionally, books, games, toys, and dollar store items will be purchased for raffle prizes, and a limited number of gift cards under \$50 may be purchased for raffle and volunteer appreciation.
