RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve the Picnic with Peralez event scheduled on June 10, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Retroactively approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the June 26, 2018 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Picnic with Peralez will be held on June 10, 2018 at the Children's Discovery Museum and sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. This special event will bring together community members for an afternoon of food, drinks, and community conversation. Residents attending will learn about district wide updates and upcoming events. This event is hosted by Councilmember Raul Peralez, the Children's Discovery Museum and the San Jose Downtown Residents Association. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

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requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
