My name is Greg Burge and my street address is , a few doors down from the planned Verizon installation of wireless equipment on a utility pole at 2512 Fairglen Drive.

I am requesting the matter **Agreement with Verizon Wireless for Permitting of Small Cells** (item 3.5, matter 18-922 on the June 26th agenda, page 14) be moved off of the Consent Calendar for the June 26th meeting.

San Jose is very diverse in its communities, architecture and environment. I do not doubt existing code and permit applications will be met, however we have a significant gap in compliance for installations placed on utility (PG&E) poles because the City has no authority.

I believe PG&E (Northern CA Joint Pole Association) would welcome the opportunity to partner with San Jose and resources such as the City's Broadband Manager, Smart Cities and Service Improvements Committee and/or Office of Economic Development. I am certain PG&E prefers their poles, and the subsequent cell equipment installations, align with San Jose's Smart City Vision and the ongoing infrastructure it requires as demand grows.

Since the matter is already on the City Council's agenda, a public meeting or council study session could be held. Our elected officials, Donald Rocha (D9) in my case, can best request the office or department (e.g. Public Works, City Broadband Manager) schedule and run it. If I can be of assistance toward a successful outcome, I am happy to do it.

Therefore I respectfully request the matter be considered separately, and moved off of the June 26th's Consent Calendar.
