#### RECOMMENDATION

Adoption of a resolution declaring and recording a statement of the results of the June 5, 2018 Primary and Special Municipal Election per Elections Code Sections 10263, 10264, and 15400.

#### **OUTCOME**

The resolution will declare the results of the election, as certified by the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters, and record a statement of:

- The election of Sam Liccardo to the Office of Mayor, Charles "Chappie" Jones to the Office of Councilmember – District 1, Raul Peralez to the Office of Councilmember – District 3, and Magdalena Carrasco to the Office of Councilmember – District 5;
- That Measure B, Evergreen Senior Homes Initiative (amending the Envision San José 2040 General Plan), did not pass; and
- That Measure C, the City of San José's Urban Sprawl Charter amendment (amending the San José City Charter to enact a new Article XIX, entitled An Act to Limit Urban Sprawl and the Fiscal and Environmental Effects of Specified Development in Outlying Areas), passed by majority vote.

In addition, the resolution declares the two candidates who will proceed to the Run-off Election on November 6, 2018, having received the greatest number of votes in the Primary Election but not a majority of all votes case for such office, are:

- Office of Councilmember District 7: Tam Nguyen and Maya Esparza; and
- Office of Councilmember District 9: Pam Foley and Kalen Gallagher.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 78476 on January 9, 2018 calling for a Regular Municipal Election on June 5, 2018 and a Run-Off Election, if necessary, on November 6, 2018 to elect one person each for the Office of Mayor and Council Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 to the Council for full four-year terms. Resolution No. 78476 also requested that the County of Santa Clara Board of Supervisors consolidate the City's elections with the Statewide Primary and Statewide General Elections.

In addition, on March 6, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 78523, calling for a Special Municipal Election to be held on June 5, 2018 to place a voter-sponsored initiative on the ballot to amend the Envision San José 2040 General Plan, to amend the Evergreen-East Hills Development Policy, to adopt the "Evergreen Senior Homes Specific Plan," amend Title 5, Title 8, and Title 20 of the San José Municipal Code, and amend the City's Zoning District Map to rezone an approximately 200-acre site in the Evergreen area from Agriculture – Planned Development (A(PD)) to Specific Plan (SP).

Lastly, on March 8, 2018, the Council adopted Resolution 78530 calling for a Special Municipal Election to be held on June 5, 2018 to place a measure on the ballot to amend the San José City Charter to enact a new Article XIX, entitled *An Act to Limit Urban Sprawl and the Fiscal and Environmental Effects of Specified Development in Outlying Areas*.

All Municipal Elections are consolidated with the County of Santa Clara and held in accordance with established procedures governing the conduct of elections. The election was conducted and the County has certified the results of the election and provided this Office the Certificate of Election Results, Official Results and Statement of Votes for all the contests held in the City of San José (the relevant excerpts are attached as Exhibit A). The complete Statement of Votes and Official Final Results are on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

#### **ANALYSIS**

At the June 5, 2018 election, of the 434,008 registered voters, 177,979 cast votes for a turnout of 41%. On July 5, 2018, the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters issued the Certification of Election Results for the June 5, 2018 Primary Election with the following results:



- I, Shannon Bushey, Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara, State of California, hereby declare:
- 1. A Statewide Direct Primary Election was held in the County of Santa Clara, for the City of San Jose, on June 5, 2018 for the purpose of electing One (1) Mayor and Five (5) Council Members for Districts 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 to the Governing Board, and for the purpose of submitting the following measures to the voters:
  - B Shall an initiative measure be adopted: (1) changing San José's General Plan to create a Senior Housing Overlay to allow conversion of land designated for employment use to senior housing citywide; and (2) changing the Evergreen-East Hills Development Policy and Municipal Code, and adding a Specific Plan to allow development of up to 910 residential units on an approximately 200-acre Industrial Site in Evergreen for individuals 55 and over and other qualifying individuals?
  - C Shall San José's Charter be amended, notwithstanding any measure on the June 5, 2018 ballot or other San José law, to restrict development of non-employment uses on designated lands in outlying areas near San José's Urban Growth Boundary, including Almaden Valley, Coyote Valley, and Evergreen foothills, unless the City Council determines such development will not adversely affect the City financially, will satisfy increased affordable housing requirements, and will mitigate environmental impacts and pay appropriate fees for road improvements to address traffic impacts?
- 2. The official canvass of the returns of this election was conducted by the Office of the Registrar of Voters in accordance with the appropriate provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California.
- 3. The Statement of Votes Cast, now on file in my office, and sections attached hereto, shows the number of votes for each candidate and each ballot measure voted on within the boundaries of the City of San Jose and in each of the precincts and that the total shown for each candidate are true and correct.
