RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the McKinley Bonita and Rosemary Gardens Dumpster Days scheduled on Saturday, August 11^{th,} 2018 and Saturday, September 29th, 2018 respectively as City Council sponsored Special Events and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The McKinley Bonita and Rosemary Garden Dumpster Days will be held on Saturday, August 11th, 2018 and Saturday, September 29th, 2018 respectively and is co-sponsored by Mayor Sam Liccardo and Councilmember Raul Peralez. The event is free and open to the residents of those respective neighborhoods.
