Losing residents to affordability issues is a loss to the remaining members of the community. - Walkability/access to public transportation: With new housing developments in particular, anything that makes it possible for residents to conduct their lives with less automobile use is a positive. I'm a big fan of mixed use development, and of developments that are close to workplaces, cultural attractions, and public transportation. - Community identity: Many residents of San Jose don't feel a general sense of community and identity.
