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Broadly, I believe it is the duty of citizens to participate in local government. That is the fundamental duty of all citizens in our democracy, and thus I am taking steps to do so in a manner that reflects my values and areas of interest. I am interested in joining one of three city boards (housing and development, human services, or parks and rec). These three boards intersect around the issues of quality of life in the city I call home. Livability and inclusivity are in danger in San Jose, and I would like to be a part of the dialogue that ensures equity is considered as a top priority when housing and development decision are being made, when we think about how we serve our most vulnerable citizens, and/or when we consider how to offer recreational, supportive, and environmental services via our parks and rec department. Depending on which board I might have an opportunity to join, my specific interests are as follow, but all are driven by a focus on equity. Housing and development - are housing policies and development focused on ensuring San Jose remains a middle class city that supports upward mobility via strong stock of low and middle income housing that supports mixed income neighborhoods. I am also concerned about walkability, and transit access as a mobility is an equity issue. Human services - I am interested in ensuring equity. The explicit purpose of this commission seems to be aimed directly at equity. Parks and rec - many services for neighborhoods most impacted by the housing and economic crises are delivered via the parks and rec department. I would like to see the city better leverage the parks and rec infrastructure in a manner that engages the community based organizations and encourages access to opportunity and pathways for citizens in our most vulnerable neighborhoods.

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I currently serve on the board of Soulciety, a nonprofit youth development organization.

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For all boards applied to, I have relevant experience and a relevant professional skill set. I have served San Jose's most system impacted communities for 10 years. Currently, I work for Kids in Common. In this role I have work to convene many parties (CBOs, public systems, and employers) to address complex social issues in pursuit of equity for old youth and young adults who are off track. This is to say I am able to think broadly and strategically, and understand how varied and seemingly disparate pieces of problems or solutions fit together. Additionally, I regularly convene work groups to address these issues, so I understand the importance of organization, communication, and relationship-building as the essence of effective collaboration. Finally, I understand quite well that with effective collaborative structures in place and role clarity, that advisory bodies and work groups can add tremendous value to initiatives, projects, or program through the aggregation of good thinking from multiple perspectives. I like the phrase "None of us is as smart as all of us."

**What is your understanding of the purpose of the Commission?**

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I am answering this for the Human Services commission as that is the board with vacancies. There isn't really much to say here, as the commission's web page makes quite clear the purpose: "The Human Services Commission (formerly the Human Rights Commission) was established to implement the San José Human Rights Policy and to develop programs promoting the fulfillment of human rights in the City. The commission studies, reviews, evaluates and makes recommendations to the City Council relative to all matters affecting human rights including discrimination, equal employment opportunity policies and practices, and recommends courses of action regarding the City's equal opportunity and equal access efforts and its programs relating to City employment. The City Council is the final decision-making body and the Human Services Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the Council and works with staff members of the City Manager's Office."

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I cannot find the "San Jose Human Rights Policy" cited above, so that certainly makes this a touch tricky. However, taking this line from the state purpose: "all matters affecting human rights including discrimination, equal employment opportunity policies and practices, and recommends courses of action regarding the City's equal opportunity and equal access efforts and its programs relating to City employment" I believe three important issues are as follows: 1) Ensuring effective practices and programs exist in the city to incorporate our large immigrant community, and ensure they have a seat at the decision making table 2) Bias in policing and resource delivery 3) City practices that ensure our City's workforce reflect the diversity of the community

In a recent such examples, I deliberately aimed to calm the energy, and then ask folks to restate their positions and the specifics of there disagreements in the moment to ensure that all parties had clarity at a tactical, detailed level.
