

### Lessons

- Online Reporting Tool
  - Insufficient or no information
- Community Concerns
  - Lack of police presence due to Priority 1 and 2 Calls for Service
  - Safety of individuals reporting illegal activity





# **Next Steps**

- Additional analysis to update workplan, hot spot locations,
   Behaviorial Insights Team mass postcard direct mail project, and outreach to determine cause of non-actionable reports.
- Brainstorm with departments and stakeholders to plan for 2018/19 New Year's Eve period.
- Department of Homeland Security Fire Prevention & Safety Grant application notification in September 2018.
- Develop more formal collaboration with Neighborhood Commission.
- Continue to develop, normalize, and track performance metrics focused on Fire and Medical Emergencies.
