RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactively approve the Village Home Dinner scheduled on August 17, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.

3. Place the item on the August 28, 2018 City Council Agenda for action.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Village Home Dinner is a community meal for homeless families in District 5 sponsored by Vice Mayor Magdalena Carrasco and hosted by St. John Vianney school. Individuals and organizations rotate each week to feed homeless families every Friday night. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Vice Mayor Magdalena Carrasco will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1).
