SUBJECT: Actions Related to Mayor and Councilmembers' Travel to Dublin, Ireland as part of the Sister City Delegation.

RECOMMENDATION

- (a) Approve travel to Dublin, Ireland and request for an excused absence for the following Councilmembers from the following meetings due to Authorized City Business: City of San José Dublin Sister Delegation biennial visit:
 - (1) Vice Mayor Carrasco (Source of Funds: District 5 Council Office Budget; Dates: October 7-12, 2018; Meetings: October 10, 2018 Rules & Open Government, October 11, 2018 VTA Policy Advisory Committee)
 - (2) Councilmember Diep (Source of Funds: District 4 Council Office Budget & Personal Funds; Dates: October 6-14, 2018; Meetings: October 11, 2018 Treatment Plant Advisory Committee)
- (b) Approve Delegation Leader and related travel costs from the Mayor/Council Travel Budget.
- (c) Approve the receipt of gifts received by the Sister City Delegation in an official capacity as a representative of the City in accordance with San José Municipal Code Section 12.08.120.B

OUTCOME

Approval of this action will authorize the spending of City funds on travel for the Sister City Delegation travel to Dublin, Ireland.

BACKGROUND

The San Jose has a strong sister city relationship with Dublin, Ireland which was established by the Council in 1986. The sister city linkage has resulted in San Jose-Dublin collaboration in education, economic development, the arts, community engagement, government, and other initiatives. The four-day stay will include meetings with the Dublin City Council and Government, the Irish National Government, and the Dublin Chamber of Commerce.
