## SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF BARK IN THE PARK SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

### **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. Approve the Bark in the Park event scheduled on September 15, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the September 11, 2018 Council Agenda for action.

# BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Bark in the Park will be held on September 15, 2018 at William Street Park and sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. This special event will provide community members and their canine friends with a fun filled day of family activities, live entertainment and vendor booths focused on dog-related goods and services. The event is free and open to the public.

### ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with

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the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
