### RECOMMENDATION

Deny the appeal from Katherine Ellis regarding the City's response to her request for public records seeking records related to an investigation, specifically photographs and body worn camera footage, by the San Jose Police Department.

### BACKGROUND

Ms. Ellis represents the homeowner where an incident, resulting in an investigation, occurred on July 15, 2017. This incident is referenced as event #17-196-0616.

A request, dated July 18, 2018, was received from Katherine Ellis (Attachment A). This request sought any records in connection to the referenced incident.

A separate request, dated July 23, 2018, was received from Katherine Ellis (Attachment B). This request specifically sought "any and all photographs" and "any and all body camera footage" related to the referenced incident.

A denial letter, dated July 31, 2018 (Attachment C), was provided to Ms. Ellis by the Operations Support Services Division (OSSD). This letter informed the requestor that the request for photographs and body camera footage had been denied by the Homicide/Crime Scene Unit and the Body Worn Camera Unit respectively. A separate denial letter written by the Body Worn Camera Unit (Attachment D) specifically addressing the request for body camera footage, dated July 30, 2018, was included as an attachment to OSSD's denial letter.

On August 2, 2018, Ms. Ellis submitted an appeal (Attachment E) to the Office of the City Manager regarding the denial of her request for photographs and body camera footage related to the incident.

On August 21, 2018, Ms. Ellis contacted OSSD staff via phone and asked to view the photographs. Ms. Ellis was advised via phone by OSSD staff that the Department was denying her request, and a subpoena or court order would be required to obtain the photographs (Attachment F).

### **ANALYSIS**

Ms. Ellis requested photographs and body worn camera footage pertaining to an investigation conducted by the San Jose Police Department.

The California Public Records Act generally exempts most records of law enforcement investigative records from public disclosure under Government Code Section 6254(f). The Public Records Act exemption for records of investigation encompasses routine investigations undertaken to determine if a violation of law has, or may have, occurred, and the exemption does not lapse when the investigation that prompted the records' creation ends. The Public Records Act does provide that local agencies shall disclose an investigative report, including photographic evidence, to certain specifically enumerated persons, including the victim of an incident or a person that has suffered property damage as the result of a crime. Ms. Ellis's client does not fall within one of these categories that would be entitled to the investigative records.

It is important to note, that if the City were to waive the exemption under the Government Code Section 6254(f) and provide these investigative records without a subpoena or court order to a person to whom the Public Records Act does not require disclosure be made, the City would then have to provide these specific investigative records to any member of the public that requests them.

### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the foregoing, staff made the decision to withhold the requested records. Staff recommends that the decision to withhold the requested records be upheld by the Rules and Open Government Committee.

Allow this email to serve as our appeal to the response received on July 31, 2013 in which the request for "Any and all photographs referenced in GO# SJ 2017-171960616, relating to the investigation of the on July 15, 2017" and also "Any and all body camera footage referenced in GO# SJ 2017-171960616 relating to the investigation of the

15, 2017." Our request was summarily denied without explanation by the San Jose Police Department, Lt. Spagnoli #2924 of the Homicide/Crime Scene Unit, and the Bodyworn Camera Unit respectively.

Our law firm, Clapp, Moroney, Vucinich, Beeman+Scheley, has been retained to represent and defend the homeowner, in a pending claim arising from the July 15, 2017 incident. Our client is the owner of the property where this incident occurred. She is entitled to request and obtain this information. We are entitled to request and obtain this information on behalf of our client, as well as pursuant to the California Public Records Act. The photographs requested are of our client's property. Therefore, there is no valid basis in which to withhold them.

Regarding the request for body-worn camera footage, the San Jose Police Department cited the information requested as being exempt pursuant to Govt. Code § 6254 (f). This is an improper application of the code section as it pertains to this particular request. It appears to be a blanket form denial. The death of No charges have been filed and the investigation is not ongoing. Furthermore, the citations to Evidence Code § 1040 and Govt. Code § 6254 (k) are also inappropriately cited. Both the photos and body camera footage will be subject to subpoena power.

For all of the foregoing reasons, we ask that you reconsider the denial of our request for photographs and body camera footage referenced in GO# SJ 2017-171960616.
