Support Program Background



- To encourage and support new commercial airline service to SJC
- Launched by Council in 2006, last modified in December 2015
- Recognizes significant airline investment in starting or expanding high priority routes
 - <u>Fee waivers</u> help mitigate initial costs
 - Dedicated <u>marketing funds</u> for increasing awareness of San Jose and each specific route
- Similar programs are widespread across U.S. and have received guidance and support from FAA

Overview of Program Changes



- Maintain overall support program in the face of continued competitive pressures;
- Reduce exposure to fee waivers under current airport facility constraints and related terminal expansion project;
- Update marketing levels for domestic long-haul and new North American routes;
- Allow program benefits for multiple low-frequency new routes introduced within a 12-month period
