## RECOMMENDATION

**Fire Department 48/96 Work Schedule Pilot Program Quarterly Report.** (Fire) **Purpose:** To provide a quarterly report on the Fire Department 48/96 Work Schedule Pilot Program metrics to determine favorable and/or unfavorable changes that may be attributed to the Pilot Program.

## **BACKGROUND**

## Fire Department 48/96 Work Schedule Pilot Program Quarterly Report

In May 2016, the City and International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 230 (IAFF) agreed to the terms for implementation of a two-year pilot program to study the 48/96 Work Schedule. Under the pilot program, the work schedule applies to all emergency response personnel assigned to the 56-hour per week work schedule excluding arson investigators. The Fire Department has provided quarterly updates to the PSFSS Committee on data collected during the pilot program.

A tentative agreement between the City and IAFF for a new contract has recently been signed. The contract will make the 48/96 work schedule permanent, among other items. Pending the ratification process by IAFF members, the City Council is currently scheduled to review and approve this agreement at the October 16, 2018 Council Meeting. If approved, the agreement negates the need for the Fire Department's 48/96 Quarterly Report to be heard at the October 18,
