SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF COUNCILMEMBER JIMENEZ AS CITY REPRESENTATIVE ON THE CALTRAIN LOCAL POLICY MAKERS GROUP

RECOMMENDATION

Appoint Councilmember Sergio Jimenez as the City representative on the Caltrain Local Policy Makers Group.

BACKGROUND

In 2012, Caltrain created the Local Policy Makers Group (LPMG) to facilitate local input and guidance on the Caltrain Modernization Program, and was recently expanded to include the Caltrain Business Plan and the California High Speed Rail Blended System Plan. LPMG is made up of officials from all 19 cities and three counties along the Caltrain Corridor. The Group meets monthly to provide feedback and receive updates on the Caltrain Business Plan, the California High Speed Rail Blended System Plan, and the Caltrain Electrification Project. Councilmember Sergio Jimenez is currently the alternate member from the City of San José on the Group.
