## **RECOMMENDATION**

Amend the August – December 2018 Neighborhood Services and Education Committee and Transportation & Environment Committee Work Plans to consolidate various BeautifySJ activities and initiatives into one consolidated report as follows:

- Drop the Street-Related BeautifySJ Activities from the December 3 Transportation & Environment meeting.
- Consolidate the Illegal Dumping Initiative Update from the December 13 Neighborhood Services & Education meeting.
- Integrate relevant activities and initiatives from the two items above into a consolidated Report on BeautifySJ currently scheduled for the December 13 Neighborhood Services & Education meeting.

## **BACKGROUND**

As part of the adoption of August – December 2018 Committee Workplans, numerous BeautifySJ items and reports were included on various Committee Workplans that addressed specific, yet interrelated aspects of the City's overall BeautifySJ effort. On November 6, 2018, the City Council approved a memorandum from Mayor Liccardo that recommended, "to conserve staff and Council time, consolidate future annual reporting of the Anti-Graffiti and Anti-Litter Programs with the BeautifySJ annual report."
