



**MINUTES OF THE
SMART CITIES AND SERVICE IMPROVEMENTS COMMITTEE**

THURSDAY, MAY 3, 2018

The Smart Cities and Service Improvements Committee of the City of San José convened in Regular Session at 1:32 p.m. in Committee Rooms 118-120, Council Wing, City Hall.

Deputy City Manager Kip Harkness, Communications Director Rosario Neaves, and Digital Communications Manager Astra Kredel offered a presentation and responded to questions.

Mayor Sam Liccardo joined the meeting at approximately 1:38 pm.

Councilmember Dev Davis sought to understand the website redesign and the ability of the Mayor and individual Councilmembers to update their own webpages.

Mayor Sam Liccardo probed for user experience improvement, user friendliness applications, and wondered if the City could adopt a new url like SanJosé.Gov or SanJosé.Cool

Councilmember Chappie Jones sought clarifications on policies in place concerning the number of clicks visitors to the website must go through to find information.

Public Comment: Blair Beekman offered comments on the website redesign.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Johnny Khamis, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis, and carried unanimously, the Committee accepted the update to the Public Safety, Finance, and Strategic Support Committee Work Plan. (4-0. Absent: Diep.)

(2) Facebook Live and Box Skills Pilot. (City Manager/City Clerk.)

Deputy City Manager Kip Harkness, and Mayor's Chief Innovation Officer Shireen Santosham, offered a presentation and responded to questions.

Public Comment: Blair Beekman addressed the idea of Artificial Intelligence around the Box Skills Pilot and accountability practices. Dr. Roxanna Mirachi, (Education Researcher representing the Silicon Valley NAACP) questioned why comments from her blog post she had emailed to Committee members had been deleted from the City webpages.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Johnny Khamis, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis, and carried unanimously, the Committee accepted the report. (4-0. Absent: Diep.)

Deputy City Manager Kip Harkness, Finance Director Julia Cooper, I.T. Project Manager Swati Ganesh offered a presentation and responded to questions.

Public Comment: Victor Sin (Santa Clara County Chapter Chair of the ACLU of Northern California) spoke to collecting the right amount to protect civil liberties. Blair Beekman offered comments on the idea of civil rights and civil protections and how to build a good, sustainable community process.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Johnny Khamis, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis, and carried unanimously, the Committee accepted the update. (4-0. Absent: Diep.)
