Deputy City Manager Kip Harkness offered an Innovation Roadmap and My San José App presentation and responded to questions.

Mayor Sam Liccardo requested putting timelines on the roadmap per when it can come to fruition.

Civic Innovation and Digital Strategy Director Dolan Beckel and Deputy City Manager Kip Harkness offered a presentation and responded to questions.

Councilmember Chappie Jones enunciated the project’s allure around the expected revenue and if it's all cost recovery, both incremental and citywide negotiations?
