A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE RETROACTIVELY APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$33,610,000 TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA VIA THE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE FIVE WOUNDS TRAIL PROJECT

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2018, the City of San Jose ("City") submitted an application to the State of California for \$33,610,000 in Active Transportation Program ("ATP") funding for the Five Wounds Trail Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project would deliver 1.4 miles of paved trail from Story Road to Whitton Avenue and a Bike Plan Addendum to guide future trail development from Whitton Avenue to Mabury Road; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to retroactively approve the submission of the grant application and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a grant agreement should one be awarded;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The submission of a grant application in the amount of \$33,610,000 to the State of California via the Active Transportation Program (ATP) is retroactively approved.

2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to negotiate and execute an Active Transportation Program (ATP) grant agreement for the Five Wounds Trail project.
