SUBJECT: RETROACTIVE APPROVAL OF HOME BURGULARY COMMUNITY MEETING SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE

RECOMMENDATION

1. Retroactive approval the Home Burglary Community Meeting scheduled on December 5th as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.

2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.

3. 'Place the item on the December 18th Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Home Burglary Community Meeting will be held on December 5, 2018 at Evergreen Community Center and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. This special event is a public safety event to inform resident about how to be vigilant about home burglaries and other property crimes. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL

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event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 8, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
