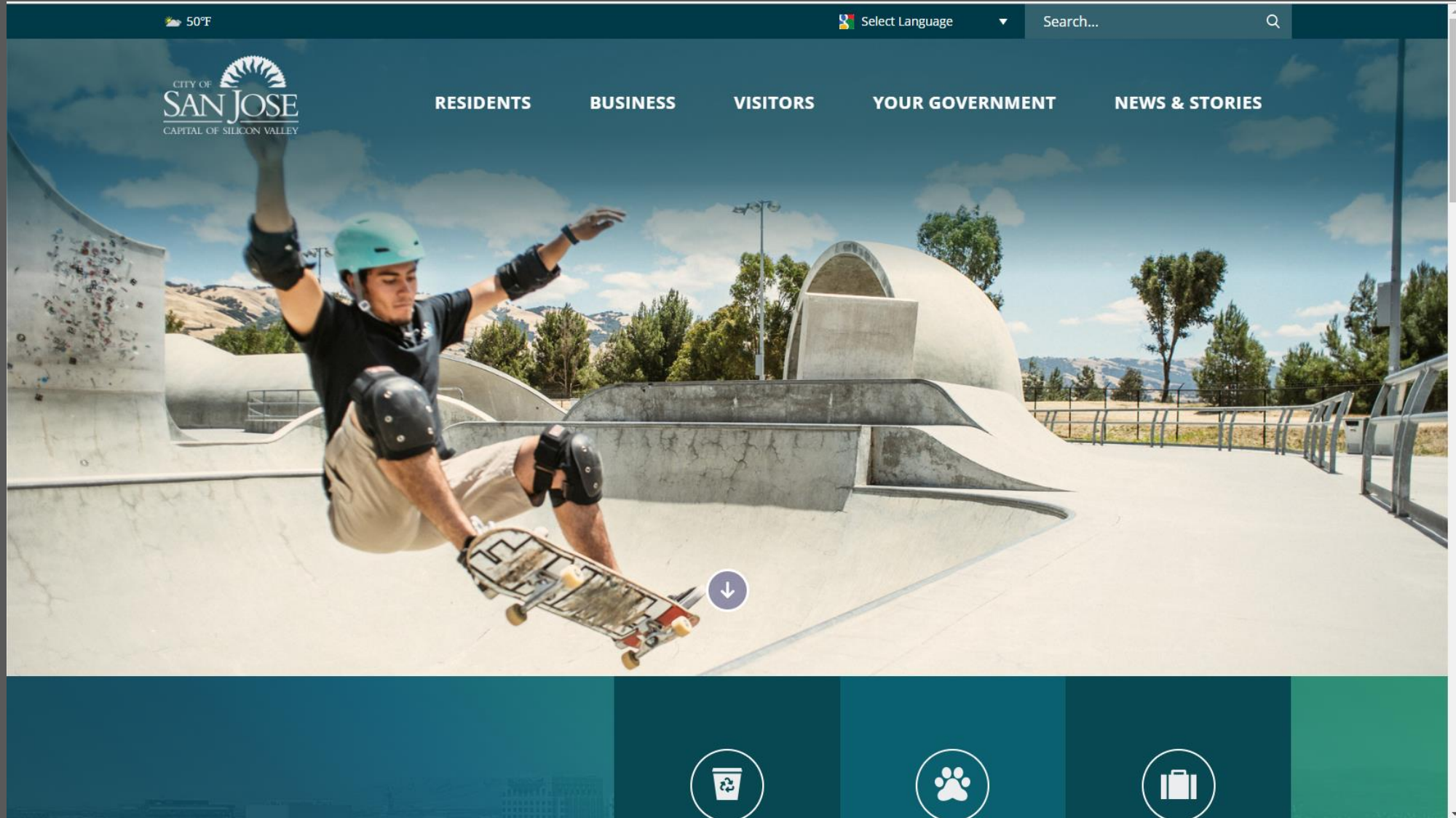

Testing with Real Users Makes our Services Better

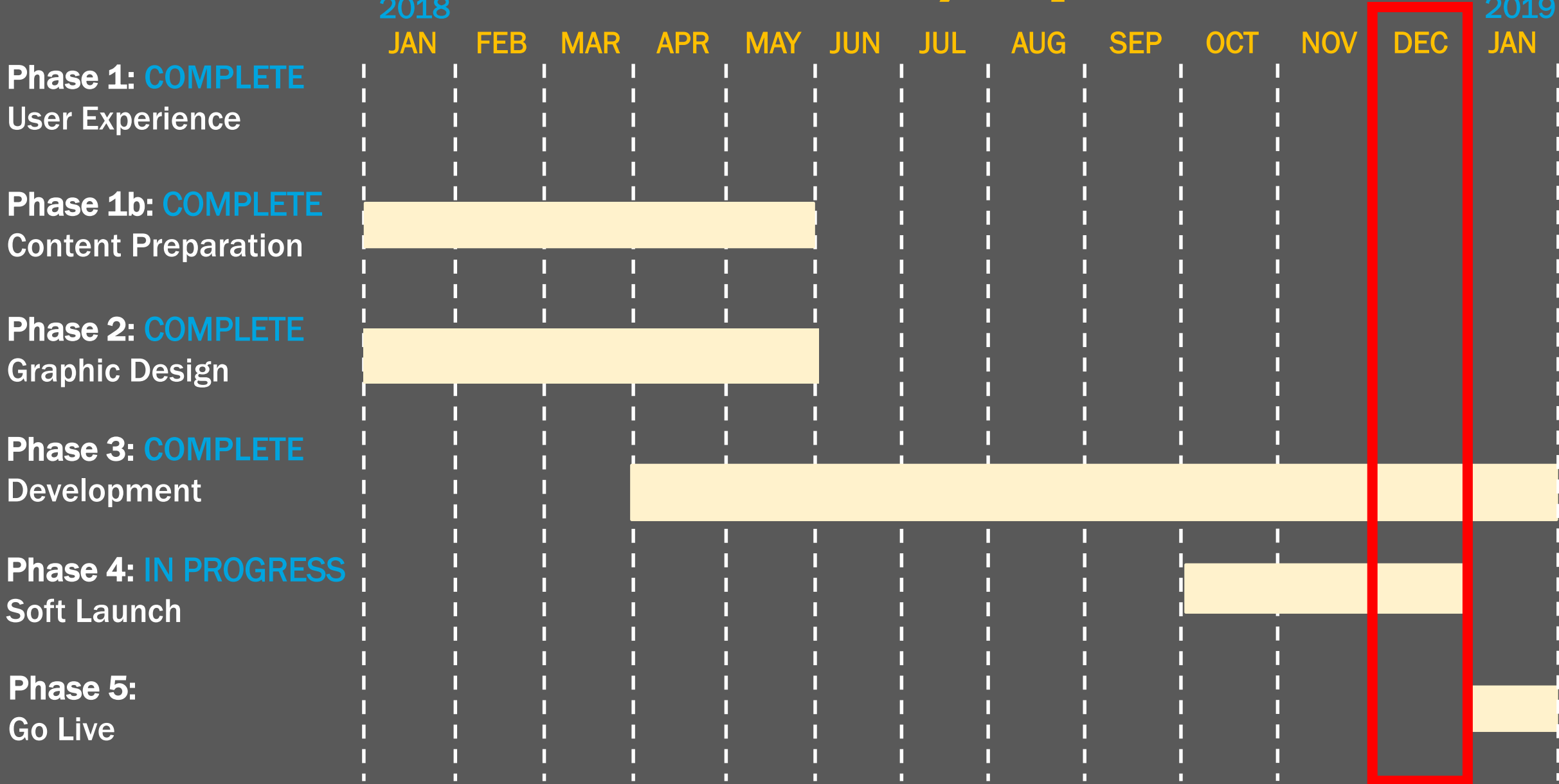
“It changed my perspective on what people are thinking when they look at our site. All they want is to get one thing done.”
