SUBJECT: RETROACTIVELY APPROVAL OF THE SOUTH BAY CLEAN CREEKS COALITION TEAM 222 CLEANUP AS A CITY SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT, TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the South Bay Clean Creeks Coalition Team 222 cleanup scheduled on January 12, 2019 as a City Council sponsored event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the January 29, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

South Bay Clean Creeks Coalition hosts Team 222 events on the second month, second Saturday, for two hours cleaning up stretches of Coyote Creek and the Guadalupe River. The event referenced in this memorandum was held on Saturday, January 12, 2019 at Coyote Creek near Nottinghill Drive in the City of San José coordinated through South Bay Clean Creeks Coalition and the Mayor's office in cooperation with City departments and other agencies, including but not limited to: Educational institutions, business organizations, and community volunteers.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmembers and the Mayor who obtain donated items will report any cash or

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in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council Districts, the Mayor's Office, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
