RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Retroactively approve the CWNA Appreciation Dinner scheduled on Wednesday, December 19, 2018 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The CWNA Appreciation Dinner was held on Wednesday, December 19, 2018 in the Cadillac Winchester Neighborhood and sponsored by Mayor Liccardo, Councilmember Jones, and the Parks, Recreation, and Neighborhood Service's Project Hope. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Mayor Liccardo and Councilmember Jones will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the
