BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Vietnamese Heritage and Freedom Flag Raising Ceremony will be held on February 5th, 2019 at City Hall Plaza and Rotunda and sponsored by Councilmember Lan Diep. This special event will celebrate the Vietnamese culture and heritage in the City of San Jose and the first day of Lunar New Year. The event is free and open to the public. The display of the Vietnamese Heritage and Freedom Flag on February 5th, 2019 is permitted under Council Policy 2-1, Section C.1 – Flags of Governments Recognized by the United States: "Flags of the governments recognized by the United States may be displayed upon the request of the Mayor, a member of the City Council or the City Manager."

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Lan Diep will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 4, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event.
