RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The purchase of event supplies and food on the December 26th at City Hall sponsored by Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco. This special event was to commemorate the swearing-in of Councilmember Carrasco. The event is free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS
