RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Beautification Day in the Tuers Neighborhood was held on March 9, 2019 at Tuers Road between Yerba Buena Road and Alvernaz Drive, and sponsored by Councilmember Esparza. This special event was an opportunity for residents to dispose of unwanted junk. The event was free and open to the public.

ANALYSIS
