SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE EGG HUNT EVENT SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENTS

#### RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the District 2 Egg Hunt Celebration scheduled on April 20, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event. Approve the expenditure of funds and approve the purchase of gift cards, and other items as raffle prizes.

2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.

3. Place the items on the April 16, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

## **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The District 2 Egg Hunt Celebration will be held on April 20, 2019 at Hellyer Park, 985 Hellyer Ave. San Jose, CA 95111 and is sponsored by Councilmember Sergio Jimenez and Supervisor Dave Cortese. This event will provide the community an opportunity to enjoy crafts, learn about City departments and resources, and participate in an Egg Hunt. This event is free and open to the public. Additionally, toys and other small items may be purchased for raffle prizes, and a limited number of gift cards under \$50 may be purchased for the raffle. The raffle is free and open to the public.
