A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO RECEIVE A 2019 ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM CYCLE 4 GRANT FOR THE BETTER BIKEWAY 2J – SAN FERNANDO CORRIDOR PROJECT

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2018, the California Transportation Commission (“CTC”) adopted the 2019 Active Transportation Program (“ATP”) Cycle 4 fund estimate and guidelines to distribute Federal and State funds through competitive statewide and regional applications; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the program is to encourage increased use of active modes of transportation, such as biking and walking; and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2019, the City of San Jose (“City”) was awarded \$9,992,000 of ATP Cycle 4 grant funds for the Better Bikeway SJ – San Fernando Corridor Project (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project will significantly upgrade the functionality and safety of the corridor for people walking, bicycling, and taking transit; and

WHEREAS, the Project will commit \$1,927,000 of in-kind local leverage funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to submit the grant application and negotiate and execute all documents necessary to receive the grant for the Better Bikeway SJ – San Fernando Corridor project.
2. The City commits to providing an in-kind local leverage of \$1,927,000.
3. The City makes the certifications and assurances required under the grant program.
