
Program Background


- Statewide Program (\$200 Million available)
 - 554 Applications requesting over \$2 Billion
 - 30 Applications selected for funding
- Regional Program (\$36 Million available)
 - 72 Applications requesting nearly \$340 Million
 - 6 Applications selected for funding

 - \$19,649,828 Total Cost
 - \$12,926,000 Grant
- Better Bikeway SJ San Fernando Corridor
 - \$11,919,233 Total Cost
 - \$9,992,000 Grant

 bikeways




