SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE DOT SPANISH TOWN HALL SPONSORED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 AS A CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the DOT Spanish Town Hall scheduled on May 16, 2019 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses and/or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the May 14, 2019 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The DOT Spanish Town Hall will be held May 16, 2019 at the Christ the King Church on 5284 Monterey Rd, San Jose, CA 95111. This event will provide Spanish speaking residents an opportunity to learn about the City of San Jose's Department of Transportation. Residents will receive information on pavement maintenance, trees and sidewalks, parking enforcement, vehicle abatement, traffic calming, pedestrian safety and more. Staff from DOT and SJPD will attend to provide information and answer questions. The event is free and open to the public.

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ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Jimenez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 2, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
